

## Information Sheet on Volunteer Clearances

Pennsylvania State Child Protective Service law requires that all volunteers, who come into contact with or are responsible for children, submit the following clearances every 5 years:

As an unpaid volunteer working with children, it is required that you complete the following background checks:

- 1. State Criminal History Check
- done through PA state police via online website: <a href="https://epatch.state.pa.us/help/Overview.jsp#safari">https://epatch.state.pa.us/help/Overview.jsp#safari</a>
- Free of charge when choosing "volunteer" option.
- 2. Child Abuse Clearance
- done through Department of Public Welfare via online website: <a href="https://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis/public/home">https://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis/public/home</a>
- Choose "Create Individual log in" when doing the clearance for the first time
- Free of charge when choosing "volunteer" option.
- 3. FBI Criminal History Clearance (required only if you've lived outside of the state of Pennsylvania at any time during the last 10 years)
- This is a fingerprint test performed by the PA state police.
- Registration and appointment scheduling must be complete online prior to going in-person to receive fingerprinting
- Valid photo ID needed
